BRBHA MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING

Accepted by the Board of Directors on June 12, 2019

The Bow River Bruins Hockey Association (BRBHA) is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. BRBHA expects all members and participants to conduct themselves at all times in a manner consistent with the values of the BRBHA which include, but is not limited to, fairness, integrity, good sportsmanship and mutual respect. In order to participate in BRBHA activities and events, the BRBHA requires that all Players and Parents maintain themselves as Members in Good Standing.

What does it mean to be a Member in Good Standing with the BRBHA for Players and Parents?

With Respect to Registration:

- 1. All fees must be paid in full within the applicable deadlines as set out by the BRBHA from time to time;
- 2. You must have properly registered your player;
- 3. You have completed any Hockey Calgary, Hockey Alberta or Hockey Canada certification requirements (i.e. Respect in Sport). Note, although some of the certifications such as Respect in Sport only require one parent to complete, BRBHA expects ALL parents and family members to abide by these principles; and
- 4. You have either paid a volunteer fee or have committed to the required volunteer hours as per the current BRBHA Volunteer Policy.

With Respect to Decorum:

- 1. Treat others the way in which you would like to be treated;
- 2. You commit to the Fair Play Codes;
- 3. You show good sportsmanship and accept defeat gracefully;
- 4. Do not physically abuse any other person;
- Do not verbally abuse the officials, coaches, players, volunteers, administrators, parents or spectators;
- 6. Refrain from using foul or inappropriate language;
- 7. Show respect for the decisions of the coaches and officials;
- 8. Maintain self-control at all times; and
- 9. Help promote a healthy and safe environment for all participants.

Any Player or Parent who is in violation of this Member in Good Standing policy will be provided written notice of said violation along with a list of any potential consequences that may arise from any such violation. Parents and Players who are in violation of the above policies and/or who face discipline proceedings from the BRBHA, Hockey Calgary, Hockey Alberta or Hockey Canada, may have, amongst other consequences, their status as Members in Good Standing removed at the discretion of the BRBHA.
