## **BRBHA** Coach of the Year Award Criteria Background:

The coach provided a good culture for the players of the team to develop their hockey skills/abilities while developing their character in a positive manner.
- 3. Demonstrates a respect for the game of hockey. Shows and teaches respect for the game, officials, fellow coaches, parents and players.
- 4. Demonstrates a commitment to improving the game of hockey within BRBHA
- 5. Demonstrates a commitment to improving their skill set through the coaching programs offered by BRBHA
- 6. Shows and shares their passion for hockey while demonstrating leadership to their players. Able to teach, instruct and motivate players in a positive manner.
- 7. Players are excited and wanting to come back to take part in hockey for the following season.
