This a simple on-line process with the Calgary Police Service, and we thank you for taking the time to complete this application. Your completed check will be valid with us for a period of 3 years.

- Once on the Calgary Police Service PIC website, you will be given a series of instructions under Perform Personal Police Information Check:



*****Please be sure to carefully review the Checklist on the initial login page. Among the things you will be asked for during the process are 2 pieces of ID – acceptable ID is outlined on the Checklist page *****

- Once you have reviewed the checklist, and have your ID ready, click the  button.
- On the next page you will be prompted to answer a series of questions, please be sure to check off “Volunteer” as your reason for application.
- Next you will be asked what Agency you are completing the PIC for:

- A series of check boxes will appear for you to acknowledge before you can proceed with setting up your account
- Finally you will set up your account and answer some questions regarding your personal history. Once you reach the type of check required – please indicate “Vulnerable Sector”
- Once completed, your name (not your personal information) will be forwarded to our office to advise us of the check status.
