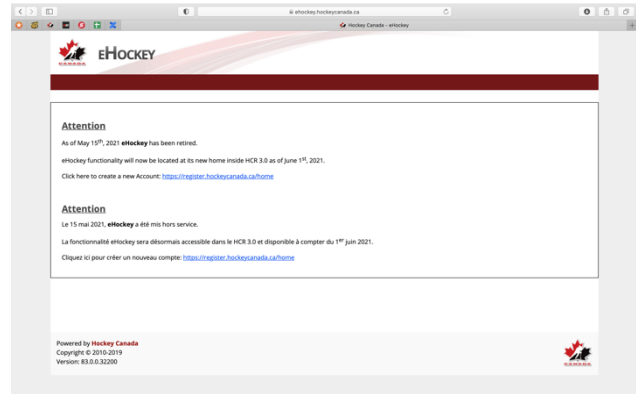


Creating an Account in HCR 3.0 and Linking Your Profile to your New HCR 3.0 Account

As of June 1st 2021, eHockey functionality has been transferred to its new home inside the new Hockey Canada Registry or HCR 3.0.

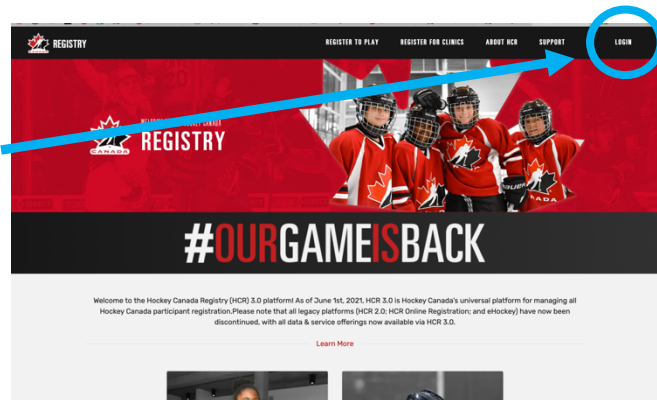
To access your qualifications and to register for clinics, you will need to follow the steps outlined in this document.

This is the message you will see on eHockey.

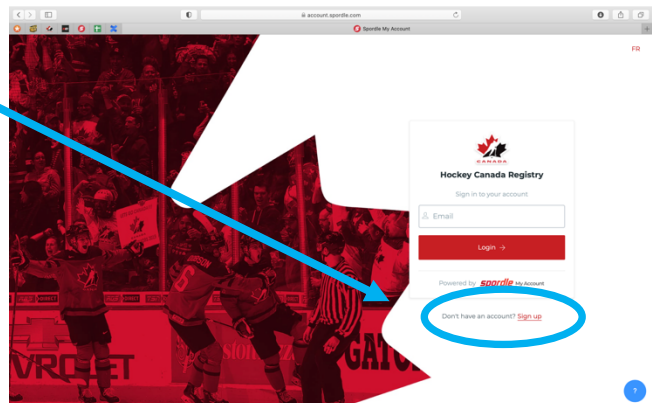


1. Begin by opening this link in your browser: <https://register.hockeycanada.ca/home>


2. Click the "LOGIN" button on the top right.



3. Click "Don't have an account? SIGN UP"




4. Create your Username and Password


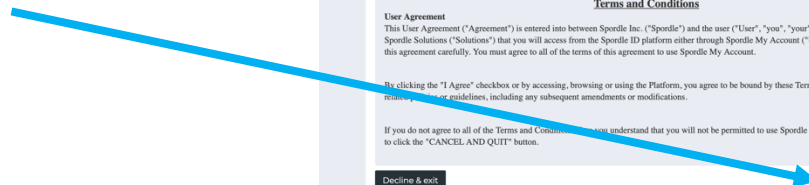
5. Retrieve the verification code from your email inbox and enter it.

6. Read and agree to the terms and conditions

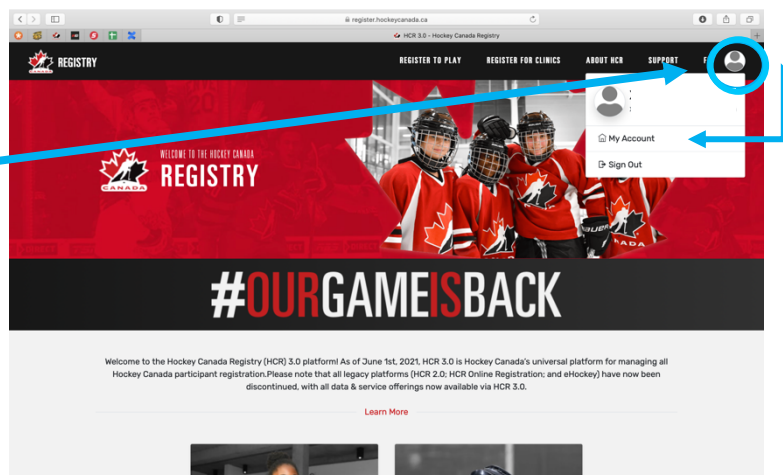

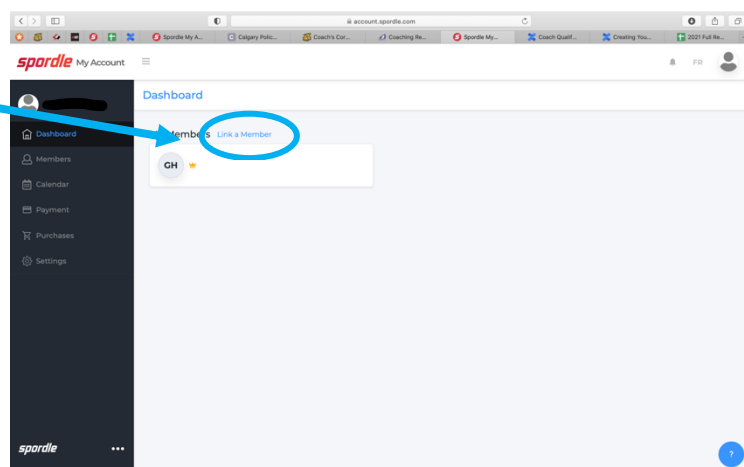

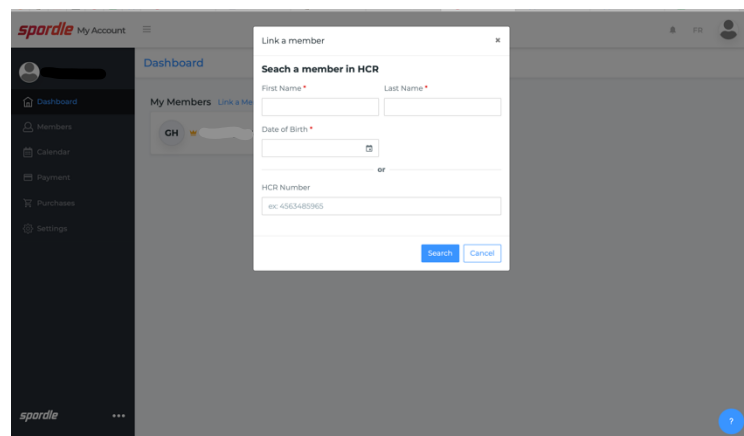
7. Click on the icon in the top right and select "My Account"



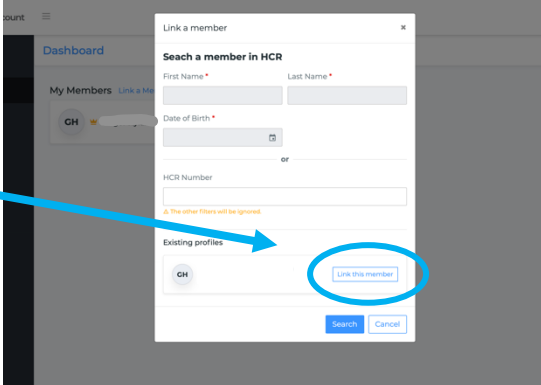
8. Click on "Link a Member"



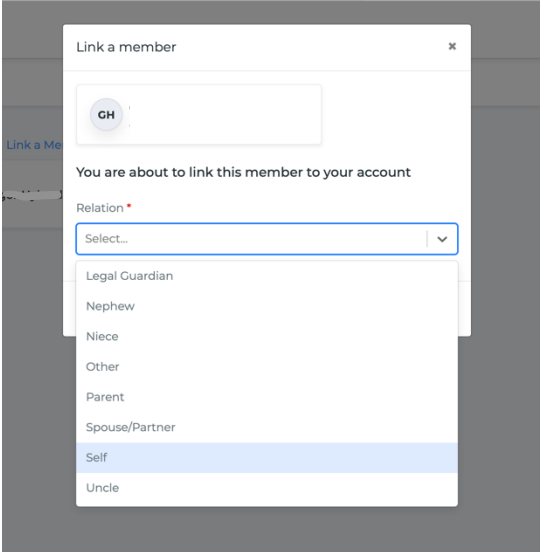
9. Look yourself up by Hockey ID or by name and birthdate.



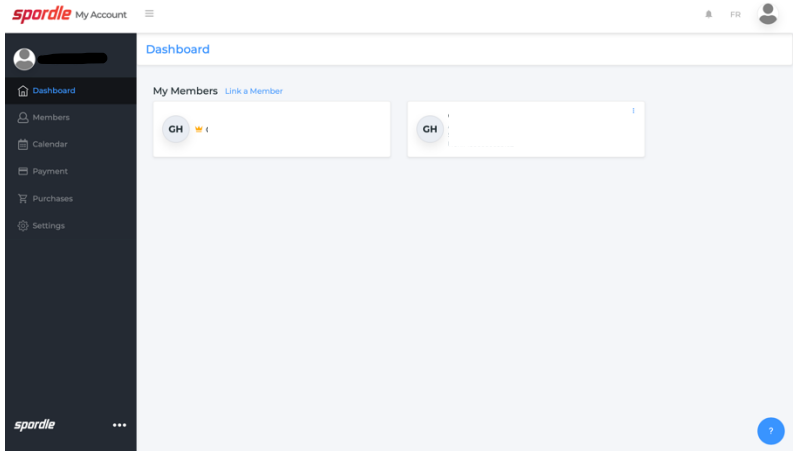
10. Select the correct existing profile by clicking “Link this member”

You have now successfully linked your old eHockey profile to your new HCR 3.0 account!



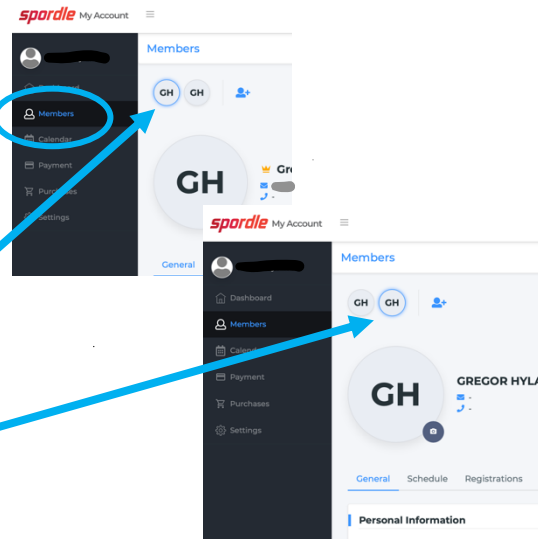
Now, let’s look up your qualifications

12. Select the "Members" tab from the side bar

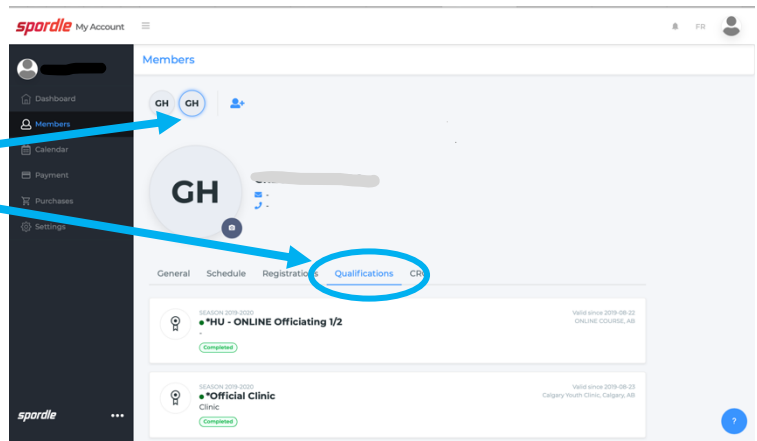
There will now be two circles with your initials.

The first is the account user information.

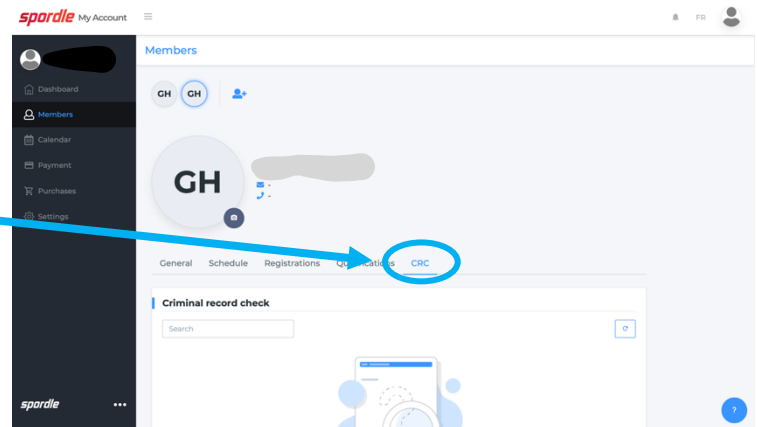
The second is the member you just linked.



13. Select the second circle and click "Qualifications"



14. Click "CRC" to see the expiry on your Criminal Record Check or Police Check.
